

Note: The following was one paragraph of a 22 page letter, which I sent to President William Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham-Clinton, in April of 1999, at The White House.

In that no response from that letter was ever received, about a year later I had occasion to hand to a member of the Presidential security services a copy, which I signed in their presence, and which was accepted by them. However, I still had (and have) no way of knowing if they ever became aware of the note, or even of my very existence for that matter.

As such, I have decided at this time to publicly post the following, just so there'll be no mistake regarding my intentions.

Originally:

January 24, 1999

April 15, 1999 sent via US Postal Service

October 16, 2000 hand delivered to support personnel

September 9, 2002 web posted

I would like to officially mention here something I have had in mind for years. Should anything untoward happen to me - and that is most unlikely, as I have always been extremely meticulous to take *extreme cautions* against physical harm to myself of any sort, *especially especially* in the worst of times, but anyway - in the event of my demise, all ownership of all paradigm materials, and all paradigm-related materials, accrues to William Jefferson Clinton and Hillary Rodham-Clinton and family, including, of course, all rights to dissemination, remuneration (which I certainly hope would be huge), alteration, and dispersion as they see fit. There. I feel much better now.
